Garber Transportation provides rides for clients who reside within a defined service area in Hennepin County. It's a convenient, reliable way for ambulatory adults 60 years and older to get to a doctor's appointment, friend's house, grocery store and more. Services are provided on a sliding fee scale.

Who can use the Garber Transportation Program?

- > People 60 years and older can enjoy door-to-door service!
- > Register by calling 952-546-0616.
- > Riders must be able to transfer in and out of the car independently.
- > Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate wheelchairs.
- > Service dogs welcome. *(No other pets)*

How do I set up a ride?

After you are registered and you need a ride call us at least 24 hours in advance and we will set up your ride. It's that simple! Garber Transportation operates from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday – Friday.

Where can I go?

The program serves the greater Minneapolis area, with some geographic restrictions. See a map of the service area on the back of this flyer.

How many rides can I receive?

Unlimited rides are available on a sliding fee scale. One-way rides over 10 miles will cost extra.

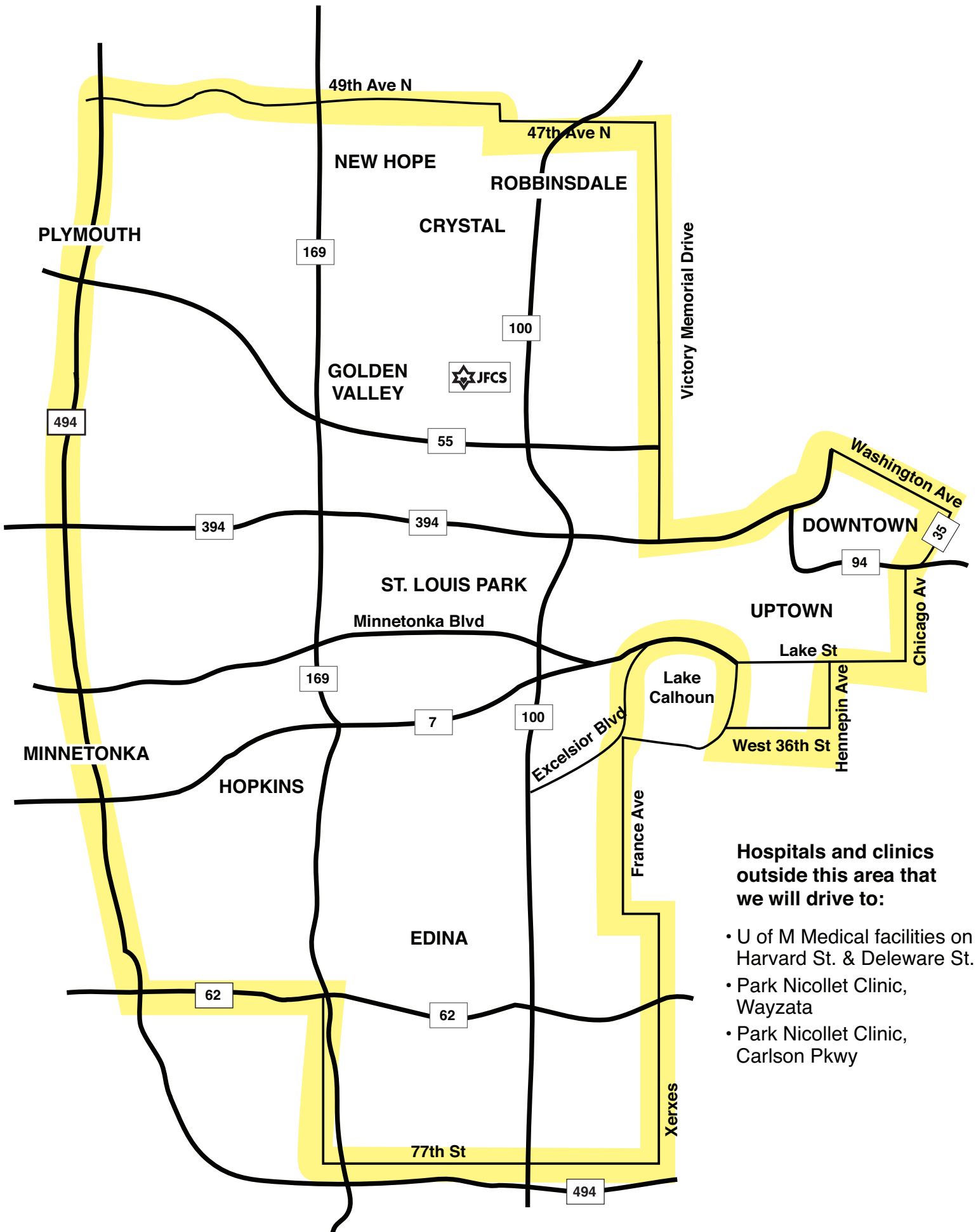
