

CARE COORDINATION

Our JFCS Senior Services professional staff works closely with adults 60 years of age and older and their families to ensure safe, supported and independent living at home and provide resources, education and respite for caregivers.

Clients can choose to work with a Care Coordinator, who become the primary contact for the delivery of multiple services. Care Coordinators provide culturally-sensitive services, and Russian-speaking coordinators are available. Services are available on a sliding-fee scale—call for more information.

Care Coordination is tailored to your unique situation and may include some or all of the following:

- > Assessing and evaluating your needs
- > Assisting you in developing a personalized plan of service
- > Coordinating the delivery of services and adjusting them as needed
- > Providing a link to other programs at JFCS and community resources
- > Advocating and/or mediating with health care providers, HMOs, home care agencies and other services or entitlement programs
- > Assisting and guiding you and your family with problem solving such as assessing housing options and/or having conversations about a person's ability to drive
- > Taking you to your doctor appointments or to look at housing options
