



GUIDE SHEET: The Snowy Day

LABEL AND TRY TO USE THESE WORDS IN CONVERSATION WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK:

Colors:

white snow
blue sky
red snowsuit
pink bathtub

Shapes & sizes:

lines in the snow
round snowball
big pile of snow

Textures:

crunchy snow
wet socks
warm sun

Numbers:

one boy
two snow angels
three lights on the stoplight

The names of objects:

stool
stick
bed
tree
snowballs

Relationships:

up the hill
out the window
putting clothes on
taking clothes off

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences. Can you make a snow angel? Do you like to go out in the snow and play?
- Ask questions about the pictures to help your child reason things out: Why did the snowball disappear? What happens to snow when it melts?
- Activity: Go outside and make snow angels, snowballs and tracks with your feet.

REMEMBER



Encourage the child to WANT TO LEARN
PRAISE when the child does well
Try to IGNORE mistakes
HELP when the child really needs it

Encourage your child to TALK
ASK the child questions
LISTEN to the child's answers
ADD to his/her comments
