Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Invite your child to read the wolf's part or pig's part as loud as they can:
"Huff....Puff....Blow your house down" "Not by the hair of my chinny chin chin!"
- Ask questions about the pictures to help your child reason things out: Does the wolf look nice or mean? Which house is the biggest? Which house is the strongest?
- Talk about the feelings of the animals: How does the pig feel when his house was blown over? Did the pig listen to the farmer?

REMEMBER



ENCOURAGE
Curiosity
Imagination

Encourage your child to TALK
ASK the child questions
LISTEN to the child's answers
ADD to his/her comments

Encourage the child to WANT TO LEARN
PRAISE when the child does well
Try to IGNORE mistakes
HELP when the child really needs it
