heavy and light

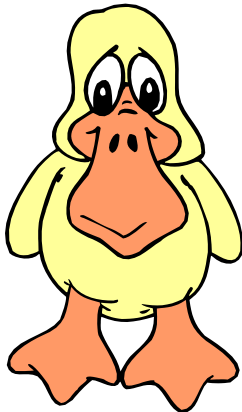
Counting:
