The ACT Program recognizes that when families have basic needs satisfied, adequate healthcare and stable housing, their children are more likely to get to school and succeed. ACT serves families by providing resources to assist with parenting support, school and educational concerns, and access to community resources.

Who we serve:

- > Any family with a child enrolled in St. Louis Park Public Schools, Early Childhood through 5th grade.

What are the goals of the program?

- > Facilitate steady school attendance
- > Promote parent involvement in school
- > Address barriers to family stability, such as lack of stable housing, food insecurity, and access to quality health and mental health care

What services are provided?

- > Serve as liaison and family advocate with schools and community agencies
- > Link families to existing community resources
- > Provide parent education and support
- > Match students with volunteer mentors when appropriate
- > Meet families in ACT office, child's school, or family home

How much does this program cost?

- > All services are free, confidential, and voluntary
